

Take UNC-Chapel Hill Courses

ON-SITE COURSES:

We serve six local state prisons (Danville, Granville, Johnston, NCCIW, Orange, and Warren), and we run one class per semester at each prison. We rotate offerings at these facilities so students can take as many courses as possible. The classes are 7.5 weeks (three-hour sessions held twice per week) and we aim to begin classes the week of MLK day in the Spring, the week of Labor Day in the Fall, and the Week of Memorial Day in the Summer.

OUTREACH (SELF-PACED CORRESPONDENCE) COURSES:

Students at any NC state (DAC) prison can take any of our 10 Outreach (self-paced correspondence) courses as long as they have a release date within 10 years. We enroll new cohorts twice a year: January and June. Students have nine months to complete the course.
